Sara Takanashi wins Grand Prix in Hinterzarten

Grand Prix. Sara Takanashi dominates the first competition of the FIS Grand Prix in Hinterzarten. The Japanese prevailed in Hinterzarten against Maren Lundby. Agnes Reisch is surprisingly the best German athlete.

With jumps on 98 and 100 meters Sara Takanashi secured the victory at the start of the Summer Grand Prix in Hinterzarten. The Japanese woman scored a total of 255.7 points on the Adler Skistadion and defeated the Norwegians Maren Lundby (99.5 and 99.5 m, 251.7 p.) and Nika Kriznar from Slovenia (95.5 and 99 m; , 9 P.).

Even the on set of a long and warm ski jumping day rain could not stop the seven-time overall winner. "I drank a lot and also took vitamins, which made me strong today. I feel very good right now," Takanashi said after the competition. Maren Lundby has already looked forward to the mixed competition "I think this is a very exciting competition for fans and athletes."

The Mixed team competition will start at 12 pm tomorrow, the test run starts at 10:55. In the afternoon, the individual competition of the men follows. The trial round starts at 5:15 pm, the first round of voting follows at 6:20 pm.
