Farewell jump by Andreas Wank in Hinterzarten

Grand Prix. German Champion, Junior World Champion, Ski Flying Vice World Champion, Olympic Gold and Silver with the team.

There is hardly a major international event that Andreas Wank has left without a medal.

After 17 years in the German national team and with a personal best of 219.5 meters, it's over now!

The sympathetic 31-year-old announced his retirement at the beginning of July and said he wanted to jump for the last time in Hinterzarten.

The 37th FIS Grand Prix Summer ski jumping offers the perfect setting to say goodbye to the successful athlete in front of his home crowd and in the presence of his teammates and fans.

Fortunately, Wank, a member of the Ski Club Hinterzarten, will remain in ski jumping after his active career. He will support the German Ski Association in future as part of the coaching team.

Born in Halle / Saale, the now black forest inhabitant, will make his final jump on Saturday, July 27, 2019, between the first and second round of the men's competition.
